PREA Annual Report 2023

General Information

In 2023 there were a total of 296 residential students (not unique students as some were served between several programs) served by Outside In over multiple programs. The agency continues to revise and implement all aspects of the PREA regulations and standards.

Audits Conducted

Outside in was audited in 2021 and was deemed, "compliant." An audit is scheduled for September 30, 2024 and October 01, 2024 for the various programs at Outside In.

Review

Outside In continues to implement all PREA standards in coordination with best practices to address allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment. The leadership team at Outside In is devoted to maintain a culture supporting a Zero Tolerance policy as well as a culture of reporting as it relates to PREA compliance and standards.

Outside In is working to update our processes for new intakes to further educate them on PREA and the resources available for the student(s). Outside In has implemented brochures and grievance forms that are given to each student at time of arrival to further our comprehensive reporting education of the student(s). Additionally, a focus on victim services via BlackBurn Center awareness and educating our students on what they offer.

Data

All allegations are reported to ChildLine and/or Pa State Police in Greensburg depending on the specific allegation. Outside In reviews and conducts sexual abuse incident reviews for all reported sexual abuse and harassment investigations. The reviewers are a multidisciplinary team with members of upper administration in clinical, education, facilities and human resources.
